

Concert Attire Information

Women's Concert Attire

- Dresses should be hemmed to a length of 2 inches off the floor with your shoes on. Dresses may not be cut.
- Modest earrings, simple necklaces or small bracelets are the only jewelry that should be worn for concerts.
- Black dress shoes and black stockings are required for concerts. No flip flops please!
- Dresses may be washed on a gentle cycle and tumbled dry on a cool setting or air dried on a non metal hanger.
- Please do not remove or write on the tags that are in the neckline or zipper area of the dress, we use this for identification.
- Fees will be assessed for any damage or loss of attire.

Men's Concert Attire

- Pants should be hemmed to 1-1 ½ inches above the floor with your shoes on. Pants may not be cut.
- Shirts may be washed on a gentle cycle with other whites only. They may be dried on cool or hung to air dry on a non metal hanger. If you have shirt studs, please remove them before laundering.
- Jackets and pants may not be washed. They are dry clean only. The Music Department will assess the need for dry cleaning every summer. You may choose to dry clean your tuxedo if you wish.
- Black dress shoes and black socks are required for concerts.
- Please do not remove or write on the tags that are located in the shirt neckline, pant waistline or interior of the jacket. We use this for identification.
- Fees will be assessed for any damage or loss of attire.
