

Logo Use



Our logo is one of the most visually recognizable identifiers to our students, faculty and staff, as well as the local and global community. Consistent and correct usage of our logo and companion elements is the key to reinforcing this message and making our identity powerful and unmistakable.

History and Design






The logo was designed to reflect the appropriate Native American culture and tradition of our local region. It reflects the collaborative nature of the Haudenosaunee people (the Seneca and other nations of the Iroquois Confederacy), as well as their valor. It features block letters CA pierced by an arrow with a Haudenosaunee arrowhead. The letters are surrounded by a depiction of a Haudenosaunee friendship belt, similar to one presented by U.S. representatives at the signing of the historic Canandaigua Treaty in 1794. The belt symbolized enduring friendship between the people of the Iroquois Confederacy and the United States of America. The students of Canandaigua Academy have chosen the term "Braves" for their school nickname. The word Braves as applied to the Seneca dates back to the early French fur traders and soldiers. Upon realizing the great courage of the Native American warriors in battle, the French applied the term "Brave" in admiration.



Approved Slogan Variant



The Slogan, "Canandaigua Proud" is a frequently repeated phrase that touts the Canandaigua City School District. This Slogan may be used in conjunction with our Logo only in the following approved layout. The font used in the Slogan is Freestyle Script Regular with a .5px outline.









Approved Spirit Variant



Only the CA portion of standard logo known as the "Spirit Logo" This logo can have 1 line of optional text below in Carton Font. Text must be one of the approved lines of text in the chart to the right.







Text guidelines for spirit logo

- Text must be centered and below the logo
- At any given size, the full width of the A in CA represents the horizontal boundaries for the text depicted with blue lines





Logo Layout



Guidelines for all standard logo variants

- Lines of text are optional
- 2 lines of text maximum (except with the "Committed to Excellence" on the horizontal logo)
- When 2 lines of text are used the first line must be "Canandaigua"
- Must include all elements of the logo (belt, arrow and CA) or only the CA as shown below





Guidelines for vertical logo

- Text must be centered and below the logo
- At any given size, the full width of the belt represents the horizontal boundaries for the text depicted with blue lines


Guidelines for horizontal logo

- Text must be centered and to the right of the logo
- At any given size, the imaginary horizontal lines from the bottom of the upper most part of the belt and the bottom of the "A" represent the vertical boundaries of the text depicted in blue
- At any given size, text must be positioned to the right of the belt with a separation of the full width of the belt as depicted in green

Parameters for Clear Space



At any given size, the full width of the belt represents the "clear space" needed around the logo, or school or district name. The blue outside lines in these examples show the "clear space" required. Text, photography, etc. should not be placed any closer to the logo
